Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The Herding Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with an international money order guaranteed in US funds.

Email will be used as a primary means of communication if an email address is listed on the entry form unless entrant requests otherwise.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies without agreement and rules are unacceptable. Telephone, telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing date.

The club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Test Regulations

Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request.

All dogs must be kept on leash, except during tests or trials. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the test / trial area. Handlers should bring water and provide shade for their dogs. Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs.
