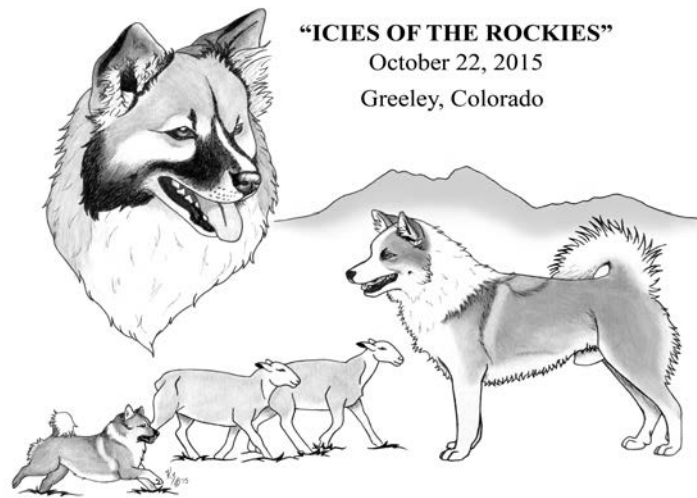

### **Directions to Hotel:**

From Interstate 25 (I-25), Exit Route 34 East to 23rd Ave. (Do not confuse with Business 34.) Make right turn onto 23rd Ave. At next light, turn right on 29th St. Located 1/4 mile on the right. From Route 85, Exit 34 West to 23rd Ave. At the stop sign, turn right. At the next light, make a right turn onto 23rd Ave. Travel to 29th St. and make right hand turn. Travel 1/4 mile, hotel on right.
