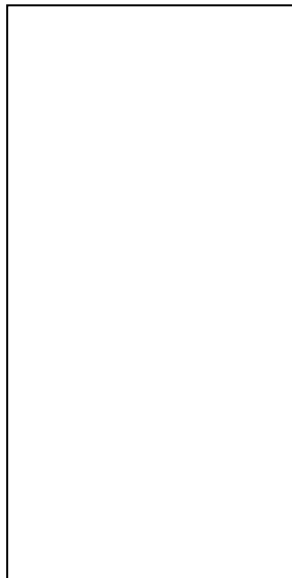

Dark Green and White Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs qualifying in the test classes.

Test Regulations

Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request.

All dogs must be held on leash (no Flexie leashes). Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the test area. Handlers should bring water and provide shade for their dogs. Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs.

General Entry Information

Entry fees: Test and Trial Classes - \$40 per entry per event [including a \$3.50 AKC recording fee].

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The FDC Test Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with an international money order guaranteed in U.S. funds.

Email will be used as a primary means of communication if an email address is listed on the entry form unless entrant requests otherwise.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing date.

The club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Females in season may not enter.

The Farm Dog Certification Tests will be held concurrently with an all breed show. Run order may be adjusted due to ring conflicts.

Directions to Kalamazoo County Expo Center & Fairgrounds – 2900 Lake St, Kalamazoo, MI 49048

From the North or South on 131: Take exit 34 (I-94E, Detroit Exit). Go East on I-94 to Exit 80 (Sprinkle Road). Turn left on Sprinkle and go to 3rd traffic light (BL-94). Turn left and go to 1st road (Olmstead). Turn right and continue to Lake Street about ¾ mile. Turn left to show site.

From the West on I-94: Get off at Exit 80 (Sprinkle Rd.). Turn left on Sprinkle and go to 3rd traffic light (BL-94). Turn left and go to 1st road which is Olmstead. Turn right onto Olmstead and continue about ¾ mile to Lake St. Turn left to show site.

From the East on I-94: Get off at Exit 81 (BL-94). Continue on BL-94 across Sprinkle Rd. until you reach Olmstead. Turn right onto Olmstead and continue ¾ mile to Lake St. Turn left to show site.
